Monday	<p>Phonics play – Phase 1 games</p> <p>Log onto phonicsplay.co.uk Username: march20 Password: home</p> <p>Search the phase 1 games to play.</p>	<p>Number ordering activity See sheet 1 (paper activity 1)</p> <p>Cut out the numbers (use 0-5 if that is where your child is up to or 0-10 if your child knows those numbers). Can you place them in the correct order? Can you make them into a ladder and make a small toy jump up and down the ladder saying the numbers? Send us photos of your numbers.</p>	<p>Junk modelling</p> <p>Can you make a model from junk from your recycling bin? Can you make a robot or a car? Can you make a rocket? If you don't have any glue or tape- you can just balance the pieces on to each other.</p> <p>Send us photos of your models.</p>
Tuesday	<p>Drawing a house- step by step instructions – see sheet 2. (paper activity 2)</p> <p>Can you copy the step by step instructions to draw a house?</p> <p>Send photos of your houses to us and bring your house back into nursery.</p>	<p>Music and dance- play music and create dance moves- Search on Youtube: Just dance.</p> <p>Have fun singing along to the music and dancing to the music.</p>	<p>Counting objects - how many beds in your house, how many windows, doors, people, pets, TVs etc.</p> <p>Can you draw the objects and write numbers? E.g. draw 6 beds and write 6.</p> <p>See the sheet 3 for more ideas. (paper activity 3)</p>
Wednesday	<p>See sheet 4- Colour people, add features and clothes. Use the outline templates of people- can you draw eyes, ears, nose, hair etc onto the people. Can you draw clothes on each person? Can you colour them all in, remembering to try and stay in the lines?  (paper activity 4)</p>	<p>Rote counting sheet</p> <p>Practise counting out loud. (First to 5, then 10, then 20 if you can)</p> <p>See sheet 5 for more ideas. (paper activity 5)- PRINT.</p>	<p>Counting songs- Head to youtube: search: 'Kids TV 123'. Listen to the songs and sing along.</p>
Thursday	<p>See sheet 6.</p> <p>Decorate the different super hero cloaks with different colours and patterns.</p>	<p>Circles- Find circles in your house. Take photos of circles around your home. Send the photos to us. Can you draw circles on paper? Can you draw big circles and little circles?  Try repeating with triangles or squares.</p>	<p>Story telling- use toys to make up a story together. Can you use your toys to act out a story. e.g. the little rabbit falls off the edge of the big bed and the duck comes to help him back up.</p>
Friday	<p>Watch jolly phonics clips. Search: Youtube – watch jolly phonics clips for s,a,t,p,i,n. Can you sing along and do the actions?</p>	<p>Pattern making- make patterns with different objects. e.g. red, blue, red, blue or fork, spoon, fork, spoon or pen, pen, shoe, pen, pen, shoe. Send us photos of your patterns.</p>	<p>Play a board game or card game. If you don't have a game- make one. Take turns and listen to instructions.</p>
