


VALUE SPRING 2: HONESTY

This book helps to teach children:

- to understand why lying isn't the best option,
- to understand the consequence of not telling the truth,
- to learn to take responsibility for their actions,
- not to be afraid to stand up for themselves,
- to understand how good it feels to tell the truth,
- to understand that lies hurt not only other people but also their feelings.
